The Viewbungalow Minerva, in the zoning scheme 'Minerva', Hoogkerk (the PLOEG-neighbourhood) is the first of its kind, nationwide, in the field of home furnishing.

In our completely converted, modern PATIO-bungalow we provide daily guided tours (except on Sundays) both in the house and in the gardens for those interested in housing, comfortable living and ART.

The Viewbungalow is a private initiative; its background is ideological and it could grow into an independent consulting-, information- and ideas agency.
Our project is not funded by government grants, but financed with private means. Various companies have donated freely. Main sponsor is the NBM BANK in Groningen. (exploitation)
