International Art Managements function is to promote selected artists from the USA and Europe by means of an interlink between both Continents; organization of exhibitions and to reach a wider public where they have the opportunity to purchase art directly from the artist.

Along with the New York contemporary artist Alan Shields, International Art Management represent Edward Higgins III, Syd Solomon and Randell Rosenthal in Europe. By means of international co-operation we are in a position to acquire prints of David Hockney, Roy Lichtenstein, Frank Stella and Robert Motherwell and we also work closely with the University of Wisconsin, Madison as well as the New York art world for representation of European artists such as Josephine Sloet and Gerard Verdijk.

It is our intention to create a situation whereby we pave the way for the artist, who is our main concern, to show their work for the public to appreciate and collect; our philosophy centers around that the basic use of art is to provide oases in a fallen world. The residue of transcendentalism teaches us that art refines, educates and makes people better.

KIJKBUNGALOW MINERVA

International Art Management opens itself to many local art organizations and in Groningen there is close contact with Kijkbungalow Minerva. Kijkbungalow Minerva is an independent advice, information and idea center with permanent exposition space for artists from Holland and abroad. The mission is to make art more accessible. Furthermore, Kijkbungalow Minerva establishes an interlink between artists and their public. Since 1991 Minerva attracts visitors from Europe and the United States.

Three architects, six artists and over one hundred sponsors were involved in the completion of this project. Minerva has an idealistic aim and is open to the public free of charge daily.

Drs. Johan L. Meijering is the owner of this unique bungalow and is also the President and founder of the foundation "De Permanente" This foundation promotes the interest of artists in the Netherlands.
